

Apprenticeship Program

The Heralds Trust Apprenticeship program is designed for those who are eager to grow in their faith and gain experience in evangelism, discipleship, and church ministry. Apprentices will be mentored and discipled throughout their service, refining the gifts and skills the Lord has given them, discerning their passions, and growing in their faith.

During the Apprenticeship program, participants will experience the following opportunities:

- 1) Practical ministry in training to reach the lost. We incorporate each apprentice's passions and skills, but also support them in going outside of their comfort zone. We expect apprentices to be ready to try new things, learn, and grow in their ministry and calling.
- 2) Space for spiritual growth. We are excited to support apprentices in their growth in faith and reliance on God. We encourage apprentices to keep a journal, recording the ways they see God working in and around them.
- 3) Service to the body of Christ and glory to God. During each apprenticeship, they will be placed in a local church, to both experience more of Scotland and to serve the global church.

The Heralds Trust is committed to coming alongside apprentices in the work God is doing in their lives.



Essential Notes

Costs: Apprentices are responsible to raise the support to cover the costs, including the visa, insurance, flights, room & board, transportation, and ministry expenses.

Summer apprentice expenses average \$250/week plus the one-time expenses of flights, visa, and insurance.

For Gospel apprenticeships, contact THT to discuss the cost.

Accountability: The apprentice will be evaluated and held accountable by The Heralds Trust and the leadership of the local church. This will include regular meetings with an assigned mentor, written monthly reports, and a final report to the Trust and the church of reflections and learning outcomes.

Learn: Work with and learn from dedicated evangelists and ministry leaders

Network: Prospects to network with numerous Christian organisations

Opportunities: The needs are great and allow for creativity in implementing programs per personal experiences and preferences

Ministry: Experience ministry in a post-modern culture

Language: English speaking country—no language studies or interpreters needed

Cultural experience: Live with a Scottish family and work with the Scottish church

History: Learn the role of Scotland in the Reformation, world missions, theology, education, and more.

Nature: Explore some of Scotland's stunning natural beauty, including lochs, mountains and moors

Practically, what does this look like? Here are some examples of ministries apprentices may be involved in:

- Street Cafe
- Kid's Club and Youth Lounge
- Local church small groups and Alpha courses
- Essential office tasks (data management, newsletters, social media, etc.)
- Volunteering and leading in local churches
- Participating in Go Teams
- Media projects (podcasts, service recordings, website updates, etc.)
- Event planning and management

And more! Apprentices are to be open and ready to jump into new projects and ministries as needed.

Summer Apprentices

Join the Heralds for a summer of intense, fast-paced ministry with Go Teams, Street Cafes, and serving with local churches in their community outreach. This 8-10 week program is an ideal opportunity for a college student or recent graduate who would like to grow in their evangelism skills and discernment of God's calling.

Gospel Apprentices

This includes preparations for and serving with the summer ministries, alongside evangelism conferences and trainings, and local church ministry throughout the year.
